## Bake Padding

When making filling for cushions, cut a roll of cotton in small squares. Put them in a pan in the oven and heat for 30 minutes. Do not let the cotton get scorched. Each square will swell to twice its original size and will be as light and fluffy as feathers for cushions.

## Use Or Freeze

**FLAVOR FIRST** -- To make sure you're getting the best flavor from your chicken, use fresh chicken within two days after your purchase it or else freeze it, Michigan State University home economists advise. Frozen chickens can be stored up to 12 months at zero degrees, but when you take them out for cooking it's best to thaw the chicken in the refrigerator for about one day.

## Celery Changes Over The Years

Fifty years ago, just after World War I, 16 out of 17 varieties of commercial celery were yellow, only one green. Since that time the green or pascal varieties have been sweetened and crisped to a point where the color scheme has been reversed.
