Squeaking Floors Squeaks in floor boards, often a source of great annoyance, can frequently be remedied simply by dusting aluminum powder into the cracks between the boards. If the boards are not too closely joined, or, simply take a thin-bladed knife and work glue into the cracks between the boards; when the glue has had time to set, the squeaks will go away. If the squeaks cannot be remedied by either of these methods, then the squeaking that causes the squeaks must be stopped. This can be done by putting extra nailing in the floor boards, using finishing nails and sinking them, below the surface of the flooring with a nail set, filling the hole with plastic wood. Small wedges, driven between the sub-flooring and the joist at the points at which the squeaking occurs, will often stop squeaks.
