Between now and November 21, thousands of Army veterans will reculist in Unel Sam's new volunteer peacetime Army. Becausemen who have been discharged between May 12 and November 1 of this year and reenlist on or before November 21 will be able to return to the Army with the same grade as they held when discharged. And the same with the same privates will, on reenlistment before November 21, begiven the grade of private first class.

Men now in the Army who apply

Men now in the Army who apply for discharge after NOVEMBER 1 for the purpose of reenlisting in the Regular Army will also retain their present grades, if they enlist within 20 days after discharge and before FEBRUARY 1, 1946.

Five colleges in the state of Mi-

Five colleges in the state of Michigan have been named as elligible educational, institutions where children not under 16 and not over 22 years of age, can obtain free education-benefits. Any child, within the stated age bracket, who has a parent in the armed forces killed in action, or died from any other cause during the war, or has since died, or is totally disabled, is entitled to attend one of the designated colleges.

Michigan law allows any eligible child to autend a state educational institution or training school of a secondary or college grade without payment of materichation fee, athletic fee, or tuitloit. No provision was a secondary or college grade without payment of materichation real attentions.
