**Stores Water**  
Water is stored in all parts of the  
camel's body, mostly in tissues un-  
der the skin. That found in the  
camel after slaughter is not a spe-  
cial store, according to scientists.  
The amount of water in a camel's  
body depends on the quantity of  
it has been given. Water and salt  
will revive a camel after a long  
journey, although water alone is apt  
to give it "the blind staggers."

**Camel Use**  
Camels have been used as draft  
animals, for turning water-lifting  
wheels and for plowing. Camel  
corps were used in wars at least as  
early as 180 B. C. In recent years  
animals used for warfare and racing  
have been selected from a breed  
known as "mechara." These camels  
can cover 100 miles a day.

**Early Corporations**  
Corporations were chartered in  
America as far back as the Colonial  
period. Banks were among the first  
businesses to be incorporated. Other  
early corporations included stage,  
turnpike, canal, water and insurance  
companies.

### GLASS NOW USED FOR ACID TANKS



**PITTSBURGH, Pa. —** An outstanding development of the glass industry is a glass tank for handling acid solutions. Above a Pittsburgh Plate technician is checking tests on an all-glass tank for use with hot chromic acid. Developed as an emergency measure to replace metal tanks, the new units are proving superior to metal ones in many ways. Strength and durability of glass tanks are achieved by tempering the glass. This is a unique heat treating process which tempers glass in much the same way as steel is tempered and is known as the Herclite process.
