Use 1 to 6 ibs. wettable sulphur plus 3 ibs. of 25 per cent DDT or 126 lbs. of 50 per cent DDT per 100 gallpins of water, or use 1 ib. of zinc sulphing plus 4 ibs. of lime and 3 ibs. of lead arsenate plus 5 to 6 ibs, wettable sulphur per 140 gallons of spray or add 2 ibs. of 25 per cent DDT to tend arsenate choice.
