





Park Aid Deadline: April 1

State Sen. Carl D. Pursell (R-Plymouth) announced that the U.S. Department of Interior had released \$25,000 toward the purchase of a vital 26-acre tract at the new Maybury state park along Seven Mile Road near Northville.

"The price of the land, which fronts for 600 feet along Seven Mile Road and extends more than 1,800 feet deep, is \$115,000," said Sen. Pursell. "The remaining \$35,000 will be made available through the state recreation bonding fund administered by the Department of Natural Resources."

"Acquisition of this important piece of land will be a vital addition to the 965-acre park, which was the former Maybury Sanatorium site."

"It will be a valuable adjunct to the state's already fine park system."

The Natural Resources Commission recently authorized the purchase of the 26-acre site.

U.S. Aid Helps Buy Park Land

Department of Natural Resources officials announce that April 1 is the deadline for Michigan communities to seek some \$1.1 million in several regional funds which remain uncommitted from the local, \$30-million phase of the state's recreation bond program.

The next series of local bond requests due by that date will mark the seventh and, perhaps, final round of such applications. Thus far, approximately \$28.9 million in recreation bond monies have been cleared by the DNR and State Legislature for funding more than 800 local projects in Michigan.

As the result of those earlier allocations, bond funds for local projects have been exhausted in two of the seven regional pools which hold the program's balance of \$1.1 million. Those regions which have obligated their full share of funds are:

Region VII, Wayne County, has obligated its full share of the funds.
Region VI, covering Livingston, Oakland, Macomb, St. Clair, Washtenaw and Monroe counties, has nearly \$250,000 in its "bank."

Paddleball Courts Open At S'craft

The handball/paddleball courts at Schoolcraft College will be open for public use on Saturday mornings starting April 8.

The college has six courts which may be rented for \$6 an hour from 10 a.m. until noon. They will be open to singles and doubles on a first come basis.

The Saturday openings have been established by the office of community services in response to numerous requests for use of the popular facilities.

Lockers and showers will be available, but persons using the courts on Saturdays will need to furnish their own gym clothing and game equipment.
