## Don't Plant Wheat Too Early

Farmers in Oakland County were warned today by Karl D. Balley, county agricultural agent, that the seeding of soft winter wheat too early is dangerous. Field tests seeding of soft winter wheat toe early is dangerous. Field tests conducted by Michigan State col-lege farm crops specialists result-ed in dates being established after which wheat may be seeded with out danger of damage by the Hes-sian fly, the agent said.

Although some farmers claim to
have planted earlief and escaped

that the fity is not prevalent every
year, the county ugent remarked.
He added that this may be a year

From 250 to 400 pounds should be applied at seeding time. Substitutions may be necessary on fertilitizers due to shortages of some formulas.


