### Bigger Savers

Folks who live in the country or smaller rural towns save at a higher rate than do city-dwellers, reports the department of agriculture. Over 30,000 personal interviews in the early months of 1946 revealed that 37 per cent of those living in the country are large savers as compared to 13 per cent in metropolitan areas. This is partly attributed to the non-money income rural people enjoy from food they grow themselves, plus a lower living cost, and a possible lower price level in rural areas.

### WCTU UNIT NAMED FOR MRS. ELLA IRISH

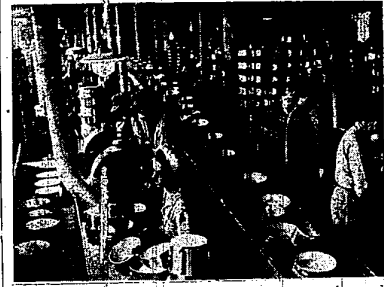

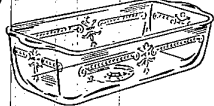
