Some 2100 recipients of public assistance in Oakland County will receive increases in their monthly grants for October. L. E. Flowers, supervisor of the Oakland County Board of Social Aid has announced. The bureau has raised its food allowance approximately 18 per cent and clothing allowances 15 per cent for the three state assistance programs: old age assistance, aid to dependent children, and aid to the blind.

Maximum grants for aid to dependent children have been raised to \$70 per month (for the first eligible child, plus \$9 for each additional child. The previous maximum was \$69 for the first child. Maximum grants for old age assistance to the blind are still limited to \$40 per month, and persons already receiving this amount will not benefit by current increases.

Old or blind persons who are hospitalized or who live in nursing homes may receive up to \$60 per month.

In the month of August 3995 elderly persons in Oakland County received old age assistance; total payments were \$108,727.69; average grant, \$35.12. Aid to dependent children was provided to 644 families, with an average grant of \$65.67; total payments for the month were \$42,228.50. Forty-four persons received aid to the blind; total payments, \$7,573.80; average grant, \$35.77.

OAKLAND COUNTY ROAD PROJECTS ANNOUNCED

Low bidders for 37 contracts on construction projects on state trunkline highways and county roads in the state and for structural steel for bridges involved were determined in Lansing October 8-9 by State Highway Department. The total of the bids as announced by Highway Commissioner Charles M. Ziegler was \$5,241,365.76, the largest letting the Highway Department has held in years.

The construction of these projects is scheduled for 1947. Commissioner Ziegler said the bids were taken this morning, to get contractors as much time as possible to get materials, equipment and men lined up for next year. Inability to obtain materials and equipment caused a serious delay in this year's construction program.

The bids taken in the record three-day letting raise to some \$22,000,000 the total of work on which bids have been taken and contracts issued during 1946. Additional lettings this year will increase this amount considerably. The next Highway Department letting will be held October 21.

Following are the projects on which low bidders are determined Oct. 8, 9 and 10, the successful bidders are the amounts of the bids, listed alphabetically by counties:

Oakland: Structural steel for a three span grade separation in the village of Orchard Lake, Jarvis Engineering Works, Lansing, \$5,637.93.

5.752 miles of concrete widening and reinforced concrete capping on Maple road from Cranbrook road west to Orchard Lake Road, The Cooke Contracting Co., Detroit, \$155,310.20.

Grade separation carrying West Long Lake Road over Grand Trunk Western Railroad in the village of Orchard Lake, E. C. Nolan and Son, Centerline, \$46,670.61.
