





DR. MAX RAFFERTY April 6 Speaker

Rafferty Next At Schoolcraft

Educator Max Rafferty will give the "Conservative View of Student Unrest" at Schoolcraft College on Thursday, April 6.

Dr. Rafferty's talk will be at 8 p.m. in Waterman Campus Center. Tickets will be sold at the door and are on sale in the college's student activity office in Waterman.

Known to some as the "little red schoolhouse superintendent," Rafferty became prominent when he was elected state superintendent of public instruction in California in one of the largest outpouring of votes case in a non-partisan election. He was re-elected in 1966 in a landslide.

Running as a Republican, he lost a U.S. Senate bid to Democrat Alan Cranston and later was defeated for his education post.

A native of New Orleans, Dr. Rafferty is currently dean of the school of education at Troy State University in Troy, Ala.

He is a graduate of the University of Southern California and the University of California Los Angeles and has been awarded honorary degrees from Lincoln University and Brigham Young University.

Dr. Rafferty delivered what is considered one of the most controversial speeches on education, called "The Passing of the Patriot" in 1961. He authored the books "Suffer, Little Children" and "What They Are Doing To Your Children."

Dr. Rafferty's honors include three George Washington honor medals and the American educators medal from the Freedom Foundation at Valley Forge; the Shanland memorial award from the American Assn. of School Administrators; and the honors citation from the National Society of the Children of the American Revolution.
