Mr. and Mrs. Fred Lenz entertained nine of their friends with a belated Thanksgiving dinner on Sunday.

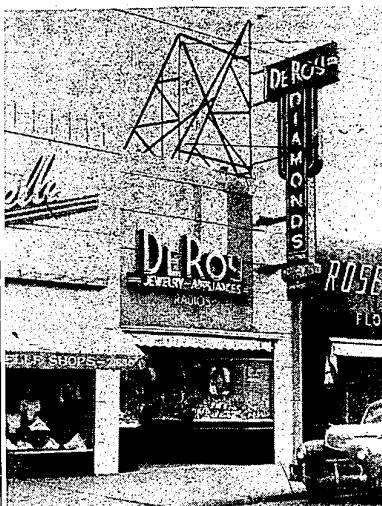

NEW INTERNAL REVENUE BRANCH OPENS IN REDFORD

Establishment of a new branch of the Internal Revenue Department here to serve the northwest section of the Detroit metropolitan area was announced today by Collector Giles Kavanagh.

The office, which is located in the second floor of the Lord Building, 17317 Lahser Road at Grand River Avenue, will serve a territory bounded by Plymouth Road, Greenfield Road, Ten Mile Road and Sheldon and Novi Roads, and will include the cities of Plymouth, Northville and Farmington.

Kavanagh said that 24 deputy collectors and a capable office staff would handle the Federal tax collections for approximately 230,000 persons.

Chief of the new division will be George W. Penniman, a field deputy collector of the Bureau for 13 years. The son of the late Thomas P. Penniman, Assistant Corporation Counsel under the late Senator James Couzens when he was Detroit's Mayor, Penniman attended Northwestern High School and Wayne University, and was employed by the old People's Wayne County Bank before entering the Federal service. He is married and lives at 3250 W. Chicago Blvd.

"This branch will afford the same facilities as the main office. Advice will be given to taxpayers, forms will be supplied, all Federal tax returns will be accepted for filing, and a cashier's office will be available for taxpayers to make payments. All taxpayers of the area formerly dealing with the main office are advised to transact their business at the new branch office," Penniman said.

The rapid growth of the northwest area, both residentially and industrially, necessitated the establishment of the new office.

ishment of the new office which is being set up in anticipation of still further growth in the northwest direction, Collector Giles Kavanagh said.

STATE'S NURSING SCHOOLS OPEN RECRUITING DRIVE

Around three hundred vacancies in Michigan's schools of nursing are yet to be filled, Miss Elizabeth Hilburn, chairman of the student recruitment committee of the Michigan Council of Community Nurses, said today.

Nineteen of the state's schools of nursing have classes opening in February, Miss Hilburn pointed out and it is these February classes which are open to prospective nurses. Hospitals which will enroll new classes in February are Community Hospital at Battle Creek, Hurley Hospital in Flint, St. Mary's Hospital in Grand Rapids, Mercy Hospital and Hackley Hospital in Muskegon, Mercy Hospital in Bay City, Foote Hospital in Jackson, Burgess Hospital in Kalamazoo, Sparrow Hospital in Lansing, St. Joseph Hospital in Mt. Clemens, St. Mary's Hospital in Saginaw, St. Joseph Hospital in Hancock, Deaconess Hospital, Grace Hospital, Harper Hospital, Ford Hospital, Providence Hospital, St. Mary's Hospital and St. Francis Hospital in Detroit.

The Michigan Council on Community Nursing, in making a plea for student nurses, urges especially that girls finishing high school in mid-year give consideration to a nursing career.

Miss Hilburn explained that there is a great need for nurses, which, in turn, assures the graduate nurse of permanent employment in almost

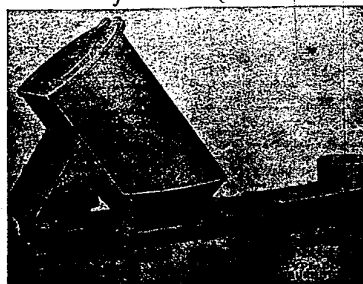
any field in which she may wish to specialize. "Several reasons contribute to Michigan's need for nurses," she said. "One of these is the expansion of health facilities, and another is the advance in medical science and the application of many new techniques."

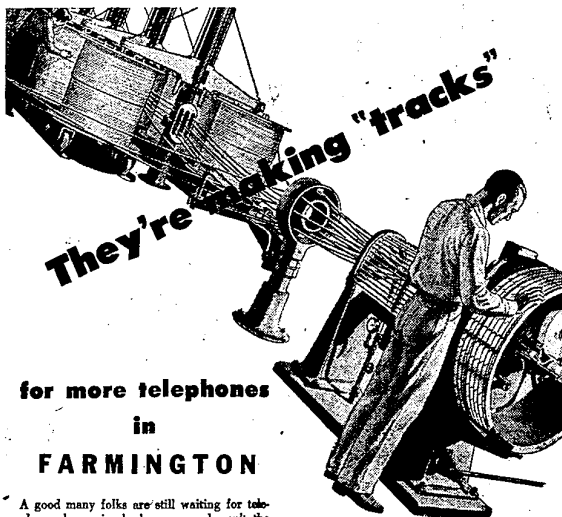
