To the Qualified Electors of the City of Farmington, County of Oakland, State of Michigan: NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, That in conformity with the "Michigan Election Law", I, the undersigned City Clerk, will upon any day except Sunday and a legal holiday, or Primary Election, receive for registration the name of any legal voter in said City not already registered, who may apply to me personally, for such registration. ADVISE WISE BUYING OF NEW REFRIGERATORS

What to look for when buying a new refrigerator is a mystery to most of us. Household equipment specialists of the U. S. Department of Agriculture and Michigan State college say the first rule is to buy from a reliable manufacturer.

Most manufacturers will guarantee freedom from defects in your refrigerator for 5 years. They will also guarantee the refrigerating system for 5 years and the cabinet and other parts for 1 year.

When you are buying an electric, gas or kerosene refrigerator, look for the seal of the Underwriters' Laboratories. This seal means that the refrigerating system and electrical connections are safe. If it's a gas refrigerator, look also for the A.G.A. star of approval. This symbol of the American Gas Association means that it meets certain standards of construction and performance.

Remember that you can buy one with the door opening on either side, and choose one which is most convenient in your kitchen. If the refrigerator has a flat top, it will make a handy place to set things. If it is an off-the-floor model, check to see that there is enough space under it for easy cleaning.

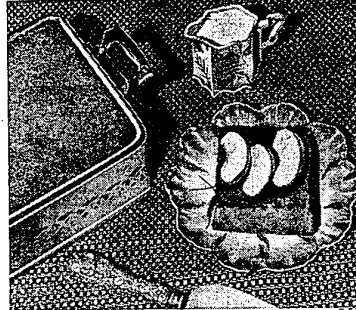
"Extra" features may cost more, but they may be necessary for economic use and for your family's needs. Some of these features are: release for ice-trays and ice-cubes, adjustable and divided shelves, and a covered vegetable crisper.

Other special design features you may wish to consider are a dry storage bin under the food compartment, a meat container that slides under the freezing unit, and a large storage compartment for frozen foods.

Snap Fingernails

When there's dirty work to be done around the house, don't worry about your new manicure. Dip your nails into a cake of soap before attacking the job and when you're ready to resume your social duties, a bit of scrubbing will leave your finger tips clean and well groomed. Digging the nails into a cake of soap before beginning work is also good cleanliness insurance for gardeners. It keeps dirt from accumulating, and is easily rinsed off after the job is done.

UP-SIDE DOWN APPLE PUDDING



6 tart apples
1 1/4 cups bran
1 cup flour
2 teaspoons baking powder
1/2 cup water
1 teaspoon vanilla
2 eggs
1 cup sugar
Put bran, flour, baking powder and salt into mixing bowl. Then beat egg yolks and sugar together. Then add the water and vanilla

and add this to the dry ingredients. Fold in the stiffly beaten egg whites.

Into the bottom of a well-greased nine-inch shallow pan, put one cup of brown sugar, one-half cup butter and one tablespoon water. Place on this the pared, cored and sliced apples. Pour the batter over this. Bake 30 minutes at 350 degrees F. Serve warm with plain cream.

HOLIDAY STAINS NEED NOT BE PERMANENT

Holiday entertaining has very likely left you with cranberry, candlewax and other stains on your best linens. Michigan State college home economists advise that you remove them promptly before regular laundering.

Heat and soap may set stains permanently. The first step in removing food stains is scraping off any food dried on the cloth. If you use water or a grease solvent, alternately rub and sponge the fabric. Rub gently so you won't roughen the spot.

If candlewax has dripped on your linens, scrape off the wax with a dull knife. Then sponge the stain with a grease solvent alternately with gentle rubbing. Small pieces may be dipped in the solvent and gently rubbed. Let the solvent evaporate until the cloth is dry. Then wash in warm soapy water and rinse thoroughly.

Cranberry or other cooked fruit

stains should be sponged with cold water first. Boiling water poured on the stain also may be effective. If the stain does not come out entirely, try a drop of lemon juice followed by a thorough rinsing in cool water.

To remove ice cream stains, consider the ingredients you must treat. Cold water will remove egg, sugar and often milk. The grease left by cream may be sponged out with a grease solvent. First sponge with cool water, then when the fabric is dry, sponge with the grease solvent. Finally, wash with warm soapsuds and rinse thoroughly.

If some color from the ice cream, such as chocolate, still remains, try powdered pepsin. You can buy pepsin at drug stores, and it will soften many food stains so that they will wash out easily with water. When using it, have the fabric damp but free from all soap and other alkali. Sprinkle it over the stain and let it stand for half an hour. Then brush it off, and rinse the spot thoroughly.
