GOVERNOR'S
PRESS CONFERENCE

BONUS PAYMENTS
WILL START SOON

Governor Sigler and other state
officials have been taking steps
in recent weeks to start payment of
the veterans' bonus about April 1.
As Secretary of State Fred M.
Alger, Jr., and State Treasurer D.
Hate Brakes left for New York to
sign bonds sold recently to fi-
nance the payment of the \$270,000,
000 bonus, Governor Sigler an-
nounced plans to have all machin-
ery for the bonus payment set up
by the end of the month.

He suggested to John A. Hannah,
President of Michigan State Col-
lege, that veteran-students who
wished to supplement their income
make arrangements to do part-
time clerical work in connection
with the distribution of the bonus.
The Governor also has approved
a proposal for a pool of trained
clerical help drafted from the var-
ious departments, to help provide
the 300 employees needed to do
the job.

Adjutant General LeRoy Pear-
son has reported to the Governor
that claims forms have been pre-
pared, and that his aides have been
spending many months indexing
the war records of the approximat-

ely 630,000 Michigan veterans who
may be eligible for bonus payments.

SICLER SUPPORTS
NEW WATER LAW

As part of a program for conserva-
tion of the state's natural resource,
Governor Sigler announced his
support of identical bills introduced
in both houses of the Legislature
for water control legislation.

"Michigan is particularly favored
by nature in the matter of water re-
sources," the Governor said. "There
is a growing realization, however,
that the present and future well-
being of the people requires that we
cease wasting our water re-
sources, that we protect ourselves
against certain dangers in that con-
nection, and that we do so use our
water resources as to bring about
the greatest good from them."

The bills provide for a five-member
water resources commission to
be appointed by the Governor, and
selected on the basis of their train-
ing and experience in water use
control problems. The new com-

mission would be the state auth-
ority on matters relating to the
ground water supply, dams, flood
control, inland lake levels, and the
establishment of water conserva-
tion districts.

POTATO GRADING
CONFERENCE SET

Governor Kim Sigler has called
representatives of Michigan po-
tato growers and federal and state
inspectors who grade potatoes to
a meeting in his office to iron out
differences over what the potato
shippers call "dual inspections".

GOVERNOR STARTS
NEW RADIO SERIES

Governor Kim Sigler has sched-

uled a series of weekly radio talks
on problems of state government,
to be broadcast over WKAR, the
Michigan State College radio sta-
tion, at 12:15 p.m. Tuesday.

This is the third series of regu-
lar broadcasts which the Governor
has scheduled as part of his pro-
gram to keep the citizens inform-
ed of what the state administration
is doing.

The other programs are at 7
p.m. every other Saturday over
WJR, Detroit, and on alternate
Wednesdays at 7:30 p.m. over WJW
Detroit.
