The Farmington Area YMCA is scheduling a full range of summer recreation activities geared towards youngsters from four years old and up and men and women interested in golf.

The summer program includes the day camp, kiddie camp, backyard swimming pool lessons, resident camp, canoe trip, back packing program, outpost camp, softball and golf lessons.

THE DAY CAMP is a 10-day experience for youth at YMCA Camp Ohiyesa.

Activities include swimming lessons, recreational swimming, boating, horseback riding, nature study, ecology, archery, crafts, hiking, singing, games, cookouts and an overnight camp-out.

Far-Oak Day Camp is open to both boys and girls 7-11 years old. Bus pick-up points are arranged after registrations but usually the points are within walking distance of the youth's home.

Each camp period is nine days long with the overnight camping on the Wednesday of the second week. The \$50 cost per nine days covers bus transportation, milk each day, medical insurance, food for the overnight, and a camp T-shirt. A \$10 registration fee which applies to the camp fee and is non-refundable must accompany each registration. All campers must be YMCA members.

The Day Camp periods are: June 26 through July 6; July 10 through July 20; July 24 through Aug. 3; and Aug. 7 through Aug. 17.

THE KIDKID KAMP, for ages four-six, is a beginning day camp for pre-kindergarten and pre-first grade boys and girls operated at the Farmington City Park and at the Farmington YMCA on rainy days.

Boys and girls meet in small groups for four hours daily. The weekly sessions run Monday through Friday from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. and activities include arts and crafts, games, stories, lunch and rest, and short hikes.

The cost is \$10 per week for YMCA members and \$12.50 per week for non-members. Kiddie campers may attend more than one period. The periods begin on these dates: June 26, July 3, July 10, July 17, July 24, July 31, Aug. 7 and Aug. 14.

BACKYARD swimming pool lessons are again planned for this summer.

Residents of Farmington, Novi and West Bloomfield Hills who have an in-ground heated pool are asked to volunteer their pools now.

The YMCA will provide instructor, administration and liability insurance for lessons which will run each day for two weeks, says Fred Lindholm, Farmington YMCA community program director.

RESIDENT CAMPING through the Farmington YMCA branch uses the facilities at Y-Camp Nissokone on Lake Van Etan.

The resident camp serves both boys and girls from ages 8-17 in small groups. The program includes sailing, horseback riding, water skiing, canoeing, swimming, riflery and BB guns, tennis, archery, landsports, photography, drama, games, nature study, outdoor cooking, campcraft skills, arts and crafts and Indian lore.

New elements added last summer that will be expanded

include canoe tripping, back packing, mountain climbing and survival training.

The Nissokone units for boys are: Indian Unit, 8-9 years, emphasis on Indian lore; Frontier Unit, 10-12 years, campcrafting and outdoor living; and Senior Unit, age 13-17, extended tripping and advanced skill training for sailing, water skiing, photography, mountain climbing, survival training, horseback riding, aquatics, drama, tennis or land sports.

Young men 14-17 also have the option of registering for these specialized programs: Canadian canoe trip July 10-22 and July 24 - Aug. 5 for \$160 per camper; Back Packing program using Michigan trails from Lake Huron to Lake Michigan at \$140 per camper; Outpost Camp, wilderness survival, camping from July 10-22 and July 24 - Aug. 5 at \$140 per camper.

One unit for the girls is the Junior Unit for ages 8-12 which provides group living experiences and all camp activities from horseback riding to aquatics.

The Senior Unit for girls 13-17 years old provides the opportunity for more advanced skill programs such as tripping, back packing, mountain climbing, sailing, water skiing, riflery, photography and drama.

The camping periods for boys and girls are: June 26 through July 8; July 10-22; July 24 through Aug. 5; and Aug. 7-19.

All camp periods are 12 days and transportation from the Detroit area to the camp is included in the camp fee. Camp fee is \$125 per camper except for specialized programs for older boys.

A \$15 non-refundable registration fee is required and will apply towards the camping fee. YMCA membership is required for all these camp programs.

THE YMCA "Play for Fun" softball league is aimed at letting boys learn the fundamentals of softball by providing that each boy will play at least half of each game.

A YMCA shirt will be furnished each player but boys must furnish their own gloves, caps and tennis shoes (no spikes or hard shoes). Teams will be furnished with bats, balls, bases and catcher masks. A banquet ending the season will be free for the boys.

The league is open to all boys 9-12 who must be at least nine years and not yet 13 years on May 15, 1972. Games will be played Tuesday and Thursday evenings and players are expected to play all season.

Application must be turned into the YMCA by April 14. Cost is \$12.50 for members and \$17.50 for non-members. Boys may sell two cases (30 boxes) of candy to pay for their participation in the league.

SPECIAL beginning golf lessons have been arranged for YMCA members.

Registration must be made in advance because classes are limited to a minimum of 10 and maximum of 15 persons. There will be no refunds unless class is cancelled for lack of registrations.

All lessons will be given at "The Top of the Tee" golf range at 14 Mile and Orchard Lake Rds. by Bob Ester, PGA member and golf instructor. Ester began his golf instruction at Eastern Michigan University before being associated with various country clubs in this area.

After leaving EMU, he became assistant golf pro at Shennandoah Golf and Country Club in West Bloomfield and now serves as golf pro at "Top of the Tee."

Boys and girls beginners' golf lessons for elementary and junior high students include five lessons for \$8.50 plus \$1 for bucket of balls. Dates are Saturday, 9-10 a.m., beginning April 22, and Tuesday, 4-5 p.m. beginning April 25.

High school students may receive five lessons for \$8.50 plus \$1 bucket fee on Tuesday from 8:30 - 9:30 p.m. beginning April 25.

Women's beginners' golf lessons involve six lessons for \$15 plus \$1 bucket fee for each session. Classes are: Thursday from 4-5:15 p.m. beginning April 20; Thursday from 7-8:15 beginning April 20; and Tuesday from 7-8:30 p.m. beginning April 25.

Mens' beginners' golf lessons are six for \$15 plus \$1 bucket fee each session on Thursdays from 8:30 - 9:45 p.m. beginning April 20. The YMCA membership fee for adults is \$15.
