

Happy Easter, Local Folks Tell Indian Kids

Indians in the northern part of Michigan's lower peninsula had a happy Easter, thanks to the gifts and efforts of many Observers.

Holy Childhood Indian Mission school and the Cross Village settlement were visited by a 22-foot van, loaded stem to stern, according to Hank Chruschal of the Western Wayne County Conservation Assn.

Among the gifts were: Two boxes of new and used ice skates, 33 cartons of new

clothing and shoes, 12 boxes of household items, 81 boxes of good used clothing, 941 food items, two volleyball sets, 14 basketballs, four new footballs.

Along with 23 large boxes of new toys including 27 dolls and four doll carriages, many other large toys, 10 bicycles, four tricycles and a wagon. Helping to fill the truck, whose use was donated by

Avis Truck Rental of Dearborn, were Mrs. Robert Hudson and Detroit area girl scouts, the Ford Motor Girls Clubs of Utica and Dearborn, Livonia Y Indian Maidens led by Mrs. Mary Pulick, and Salem United Church of Christ, Farmington.

In a whirlwind drive, four girls from Livonia's Churchill High School collected 120 cans of food and 30 bars of soap. Other new helpers in the cause were:

Church of the Holy Spirit, Westland; 23 employees of an area department store (\$53 check); and Mr. Gladys Smith, of Westland, who helped Mrs. Chruschal by sewing many articles of clothing.

Paul Cooper and Ed Goldstein aided in fixing toys and loading the truck.

Eligibility for participation in an amateur photographer's contest being conducted in association with Michigan Artrain's coming visit to Plymouth has been extended to include residents throughout Observersland.

The contest has been named "PLYFOTOSHO," and is one of the activities sponsored by Kaleidoscope. Plymouth, which has booked Artrain for a Plymouth appearance April 19 through May 6.

Originally the contest was planned for residents of the Plymouth area only.
