NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that a special election will be held in Farmington Public School District, County of Oakland, and State of Michigan, on Monday, the 24th day of April, 1978, for the purpose of electing the following proposition:  
That the limitation of the total amount of general ad valorem taxes which may be imposed for all purposes in any one year upon real or personal property in Farmington Public School District, Oakland County, Michigan, be increased as provided in Section 6, Article IX, of the Constitution of Michigan for the year 1977 by three centimes (3%) mills on each dollar (\$1.50 per \$1,000) of the assessed value of property on the basis of equalization, for the purpose of defraying the cost of the operating expenses of the school district.
