Vacation Highlights by The Old AAA Traveler



Ancient Williamsburg, with its magnificent old buildings, beautiful women in Colonial costumes, brilliant flowers — and you have the ideal summer vacation objective.

WILLIAMSBURG

Springtime in Virginia is a gorgeous season, what with the rhododendron and redbud, flame azalea and dogwood, mountain laurel and the apple trees in bloom, and no where in that state of beautiful women and gallant men is beauty in higher relief than around ancient Williamsburg.

Williamsburg, of course, is one of the great Virginia highlights, for it is there that the Rockefeller millions have re-created the Williamsburg of a couple of centuries ago, the Williamsburg which was looked upon as being just as brilliant in its social life as the Court of St. James. There the great and near-great assembled to make the have and to live a life rich and famous in all of its ramifications.

Today Duke of Gloucester Street, with the College of William and Mary at one end and the re-created Capitol at the other, stretches its shady length as it did when fine ladies in hoop skirts and men in long-skirted coats paraded under the trees. Most of the old buildings have been re-created to stand

just as they did in Williamsburg's halcyon days.

Williamsburg is almost unbelievably rich in history, hence it is an objective for teachers and students alike. Along with its rich history, Williamsburg has color and romance and adventure. All that and more you find today in this re-created town.

There is sort of stroll around Williamsburg and see what we shall see. There is the old Court House and the Capitol, the Gaol and Raleigh Tavern, the Governor's Palace and Wythe House, historic Bruton Parish Church and Tazewell Hall, and on through the impelling parade of the buildings in which much of Virginia's early history was unrolled like a gigantic Technicolor film.

Williamsburg, of course, originally was an outpost of Jamestown, and after the burning of the State House at Jamestown, Williamsburg became the capital. When the capital was moved from Jamestown to what then was known as "Middle Plantation", the name was changed to Williamsburg in honor of William III. It continued to be the capital for 80 years.

Ah yes, Williamsburg has everything the early summer vacationist could desire—in the way of beauty and romance, but that entire Virginia is a vast stage across which, in bygone days, marched the stout-hearted men who gave us America. It matters not where you travel in Virginia, you will find history and romance and color and beauty. Richmond, for example, literally reeks with history, and the same might be said of Alexandria and Charlottesville, Fredericksburg and Lexington, Norfolk and old Jamestown, or what remains of it, Petersburg and Winchester and the score of Civil War battlefields scattered through the state like currants through a fruitcake.

Yes, Virginia is beautiful at any time of the year, but it is probably more beautiful in the early summer than at any other time. This is especially true down through the Shenandoah Valley and along the Blue Ridge Parkway. Nowhere in all the world will you find more in spring glories than in Virginia when the laurel and flame azalea are out.

Virginia has high appeal to Michiganders, for it is only a modest drive from any point in Michigan before you are into the glories which have elicited song and story from those who love beauty, so why not Virginia this year?
