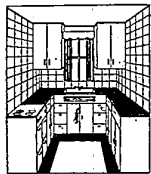

my feeling is that if we get out of the scotter's seat for a moment, if we drop the cry and put pressure into the national vocabulary, we may make it work.

BUILDING INGENUITY SPURS INQUIRIES

I don't know how interested you readers have been in my reports of what American ingenuity in different communities has done to make for veterans' homes. But I can't say that it is without the straw (of readily available materials and labor) which we seem to lack in this otherwise rich and prosperous land of ours. But I can tell you that a lot of people who thought they could go and do likewise were heard from.

Yakima, Wash., whose achievement was the first described in this column, has had requests for information in person. Delegations have come to Yakima from Spokane, Seattle, Walla Walla, Ephrata, Pasco, Prosser, Ellensburg and Blytheville in Washington, and from Portland and Pendleton in Oregon.

The Salem plan, under which the city is subsidizing the conversion of extra space into new apartments has drawn comment from a number of other Massachusetts towns. Gloucester already has copied part of the plan, and inquiries have come in from five other cities in the Bay state, and from state offices of Amvets, VFW and American Legion.

The veterans' co-operative which has been so successful in building moderate cost housing in Albuquerque, N.M., has been busy answering questions. Two requests have come from Houston and Amarillo, Tex., from Syracuse, N.Y., Gloucester, Mass.; Las Cruces, N.M.; Great Falls, Mont.; Erie, Pa.; Berkeley, Cal.; Oklahoma City, Detroit and elsewhere.

The success of Rochester, N.Y., in providing living space has brought in an impressive list of queries from other communities which haven't yet solved their housing problems. Chambers of commerce in Bristol, Tenn., and Farrell, Pa., and in half a dozen New York and Massachusetts towns have inquired. Twenty-nine banks in 14 states and one in Canada have written in for details. Housing committees in Ann Arbor, Mich., and San Antonio, Texas, have asked for the story, as have a dozen other committees in cities near to Rochester. State, local and national offices of veterans' organizations have asked about the Rochester plan. A professor of city planning at Massachusetts Institute of Technology and a professor of economics at University of California have written in.

Richmond, Ind., where the local business men set up a corporation to build prefabricated houses, also has come in for some questioning. Dayton and Cleveland, Ohio, Matteson, Ill., Shelbyville and Connersville, Ind., have sent representatives to Richmond to study the project. Other nearby communities have inquired by letter. And the mayor of Richmond received one letter from E. H. Bradshaw of the Communal
