And the ter-race outlet should never be used as a road for hauling fruit or for spray quipment. the specialists warn. Other miethods of preventing ero-sion include mulching and sod cov-ers, both of which, have great use and which are discussed in Circular Bulletin 139 from Michigan State College.
