of neglect should not be permitted to continue for another generation."

For some time we have sensed an intangible "chip-on-the-shoulder" attitude in the U.P. This region tends to think of itself as the underdog, the forgotten child who is forever getting a raw deal. Such an attitude is a natural reaction to the basic trouble of the region: It has been acutely exploited by absentee ownership. It has been a colony whose natural resources have been stripped for the profit of people who live elsewhere. Even its raw lumber and ores have been transported outside of the region to be converted into wages and stockholder profits through industrial processing.

We can't agree with our Wisconsin newspaper friend that a solution of all this is for the Upper Peninsula to secede from Michigan. We feel that the region has a good case, because of its exploitation, for a greater share of improvements which will assist the local people to help themselves. What are the prospects in the Upper Peninsula? We would like to discuss some of them in this column next week.

Redford is farther, but it's much easier on my blood pressure.

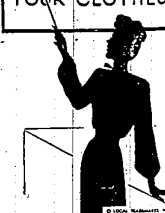

ling candidate) to keep himself constantly informed and in touch with the nation."

This work of weaving this "communications net" is an exciting story too long to recount here, but let me quote Major McNally briefly to show how continuous communication was maintained when President Roosevelt made one of his frequent trips to Hyde Park.

"A 50-watt frequency modulation station was modified and installed on the secret service car attached to the presidential train. Army vehicles, radio equipped, were spotted at strategically plotted points along the route between Washington and Poughkeepsie, so that the train was in constant touch all the way. Another FM radio link was installed in the old stable on the President's estate at Hyde Park. By means of a direct telephone line to Washington and frequency modulation radio, the White House was kept informed of the President's whereabouts at all times."

The speed with which messages could be dispatched and answers received, was astounding. When Winston Churchill was making his second visit to Hyde Park, he and the President who were keen competitors as well as close collaborators decided to make a speed test on the communications facilities. Each sent identical messages to Australia over the respective British and United States facilities. The President had an answer in less than two hours; the Prime Minister got his the next day.

The signal corps, like the secret service, (and working closely with the secret service) to Tehran establishing relay points for their channels along the way and at all the many stopping points - Cairo, Malta, Casablanca. The same was true at Yalta on the Black Sea.

In perfecting these arrangements, Major McNally claims a long list of "firsts." Here are some of them: First to construct and operate a long-range mobile radio station in a railroad car with high powered equipment; first to design and develop pocket-size frequency modulation radio transmitters and receivers; first to keep a United States president in 24-hour communication from any point on the North American continent to any point in the world.
