Program Will Guard Home Against Thefts

FARMINGTON

A program to help reduce residential burglaries by assisting residents in marking valuables for quick identification has been launched in Farmington.

Sponsoring the program, called "Project Theft - Guard," is the Soroptimist Club of Farmington which will implement it in cooperation with the Farmington police department.

PURPOSE OF THE program is to get Farmington families to mark all valuables in and around their homes with their driver's license number.

Electric engravers that mark metal, wood, plastic, etc., will be loaned free to any family who wants to participate. Stickers identifying their home as a participant, to be posted in the front and back doors are available at most engraving centers or by mail from the Soroptimist Club of Farmington, P.O.B. 504, Farmington, 48024.

According to Mrs. Fran Evert, chairwoman of the project committee, "Project Theft - Guard," electric engravers will be kept on hand at these locations:

Farmington City police headquarters, 2300 Liberty St.; Farmington Township Police headquarters, 3155 W. 11 Mile Rd.; Novi City Police headquarters, 25850 Novi Rd.; Farmington Chamber of Commerce, 23715 Farmington Rd.; and the Farmington Board of Education, 32500 Shiawasse.

An engraver will be loaned free for use by all residents wishing to participate.

A participant will use the engraver to engrave his driver's license number on all valuables kept in their home. At the same time, he will list the valuables so engraved on a special form provided at the engraving centers.

When the engraver is returned to the engraving center, the participant can then purchase special "Project Theft - Guard" stickers at a cost of 25 cents each. These stickers are placed on or near the front and back doors of the residence.

MRS. EVERT points out that in Monterey Park, Calif., where a program of this type was first instituted in 1963, more than 4,000 households were participating by 1971. During this first eight years of the program, only three had been burglarized.

First, "fences," the people who buy and sell stolen goods, do not like to deal with merchandise that is readily identifiable.

Second, thieves are not anxious to be caught with merchandise on their persons that law enforcement officials can prove belong to someone else.

Third, although the engraved numbers can be filed off, the fact that they are there, makes life harder for the burglar.
