Red Dane Dairy Cattle Sale Set For October 21

Michigan dairymen who are interested in the newest of all dairy breeds, Red Danes, will have an opportunity to buy them at the second sale of surplus Red Dane cattle, according to A. C. Baltzer, extension dairyman at Michigan State college.

The sale will be held at the Otto Klein farm near Harrisville, on October 21. It is expected that about 35 animals, mostly first and second crop cows, will be offered. A few bred heifers will also be sold.

Baltzer points out that Alcona county Red Danish breeders have had excellent success in their efforts to develop this breed of cattle by using sires of this breed with rich milk and percent test inheritance.

LOST WAR BONDS

Question: Where does a veteran write for the purpose of procuring the serial number of lost or destroyed war bonds which he originally purchased through military channels while he was in the armed forces?

Answer: ARMY — Saving Bond Branch, Army Finance Center, GCP, Building 264, 4200 Goodfellow Blvd., St. Louis 20, Missouri.

NAVY — Bond Division, Field Branch, Bureau of Supplies and Accounts, Navy Department, 13th and Canal, Cleveland 15, Ohio.

MARINE CORPS — War Bond Issuing Office, Headquarters, U. S. Marine Corps, Washington 25, D.C.

COAST GUARD — War Bond Assignment Section, Office of Finance and Supply, U. S. Coast Guard, Headquarters, Washington 25, D.C.

Question: If the veteran knows the serial numbers of lost, stolen or destroyed war bonds, where does he write?

Answer: In the case of the Navy, Marine Corps, or Coast Guard, he should write to the same address as in the previous question-answer. In the case of the Army, the address here should be: Treasury Department, Division of Loans and Currency, Merchandise Mart, Chicago, 51, Illinois.

BANG'S TESTING PLACED ON AREA BASIS IN STATE

Bang's disease area test work is being conducted in Michigan at four main points, according to Dr. C. F. Clark, State Veterinarian.

In the Upper Peninsula 4 Federal and State veterinarians assisted by two local veterinarians are working in Houghton and Keweenaw Counties. As soon as work is completed, they will move on to another county selected according to weather and traveling conditions existent at the time. Previous to the work in Houghton, the cattle from Mountain were tested. The low amount of Bang's infection located, permitted Iroh County to be re-credited. Samples drawn from cattle in the Upper Peninsula area are tested in the State laboratory of the Department of Agriculture at Escanaba.

In the northern part of lower Michigan, seven Federal and State veterinarians operate from a trail or laboratory. They have finished testing the cattle of Grand Traverse and Leelanau Counties, and are now located at Manistowic to test the cattle of that county.

The trail laboratory in Central Michigan has for some time been situated at Caro. Tests in Tuscola County have been completed, and the infected herds have been retested. Work has now begun on area test of Saginaw County. In addition to the six regularly employed State and Federal veterinarians, several local veterinarians will assist on a part-time basis.

During the forepart of September a testing for Western Michigan was established at Big Rapids. Three Federal and State, and five local veterinarians are testing the cattle in northern and central Newaygo County. When the testing of Newaygo county cattle is completed, the group will move to Mecosta county for area test of cattle there.
