Dairymen Advised To Keep Cows Stabled At Night

With cooler nights here, dairymen should keep cows stabled, advises Ed Alchin, assistant county agrentitural agent. Cold, wet days will cause cows to stand around outdoors with their backs humped up and tails tucked between their lees, probably wondering where to go to get their next bite of fool.

' Cows should be fed one pound of grain daily for the total pounds of fat produced in a week. For example, a cow giving 49 pounds of four percent milk would produce ten pounds of fat per week and should receive ten pounds of grain daily.

According to past records, November is usually the lowest month in terms of pounds of milk per day. Feeding cows hay, silage and grain will tend to reduce this drop in milk production.
