Mass Moving

On At Hazel

The biggest parade in Hazel

Park race track history is now

under way. A mass moving of

700 horses who raced during

the early part of the meeting

are leaving to be replaced by

outstanding stables containing

the same number of thorough-

bred for the 90 days' session

which starts on Monday.

During the next 90 days

there'll be a \$3,000 minimum

purse schedule in effect, put-

ting Hazel Park among the

better tracks in the country.

There is also an attractive

stakes program with \$270,000

in purses topped by the annual

\$50,000 Michigan Derby, June

10.

Nine races are carded each

day with an extra race on

Saturdays and Sundays.

According to Bert Thomp-

son, director of racing, the

suburban track has the finest

collection of stables in its his-

tory on the grounds.

Most have been campaign-

ing in Oakland, Hialeah, Gul-

stream and New Orleans.

Most of the stables coming

from Oakland made major

contributions to the success of

Hot Springs track, one of the

most spectacular showings in

turf history.

With its new purse schedule

aided by the increase in

mutual takeout Michigan rac-

ing moves into the forefront

of the country. More than \$4

million will be offered in

purses here and with another

hefty amount available from

DRC. Later in the year the

better stables find it most

profitable to campaign in

Michigan during the 240 days

of continuous racing.

There is a record colony of

55 riders on the grounds with

about 20 more due with some

of the bigger stables arriving.

Stevenson Wins Pair

Livonia Stevenson zipped

past Ed Ford, 63-69, and

completely overpowered

Walled Lake Central, 99-24,

to stand at two wins and one loss

in track dual meet com-

petition.

Neil Bowby was a double

winner for Stevenson against

Edsel Ford with a 6'2" in the

high jump and a 15:4 in high

hurdles.

Other individual winners

were Chuck Babcock (long

jump); Dennis O'Keefe (pole

vault); Walker (880 run); and

Kevin Maly (two mile).

Stevenson also won the mile

relay with a time of 3:33.1.

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
