



Electric Lights Increase Egg Laying

CHEMICAL RETARDS SPROUTING OF STORED ROOT CROPS

Excessive sprouting of stored po-tatoes and root crops causes ser-ious losses to Michigan 'tamers each year. According to S. H. Wil-wer, specialist in horticulture at Michigan State college, a new li-quid chemical prevents or greatly retards growth of sprouts and shriveling of tubers. Chemical treatments for prevent-ting surrouting will logerthen the

Chemical treatments for prevent-ing aprouting will lengthen the storage life of the crop, permit storage of some products at higher temperatures than would otherwise be practical, and will not in any way affect the taste or eating qual-ity of table stock.

ity of table stock.

Although the chemical has a tongue-twisting name (methyl ester of alpha-naphthaleneacetic acid), it is on the market under several commercial names. Such small quantities of it are required to treat produce that manufacturers are now offering it for sale mixed with some filler. One method has been to treat shredded or confetti paper with the chemical and then distribute the paper in the bin with the produce.
