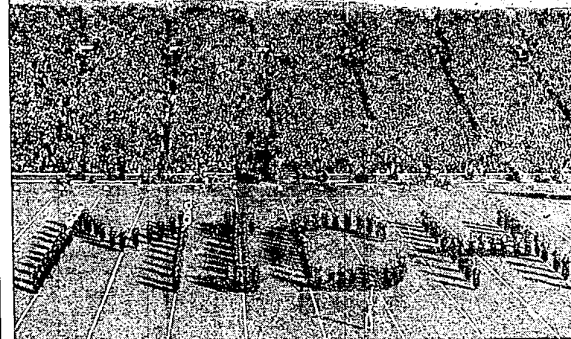

Decline in Muskrats Prompts Investigation

A double-barreled investigation of the decline in muskrat numbers in the Muskegon state game area marshes is underway.

Dr. S. C. Whitlock, conservation department pathologist, is making autopsies of 'rats' taken in the current trapping season.

Weather has been most unfavorable to rats and trappers for more than a year. Many muskrats perished or emigrated in the summer of 1946 when many small marshes and notches went dry.

Extreme cold early in December produced shell ice in some marshes to handicap trappers at the start of the season in the southern zone.

Some southern districts report 'rat numbers no better than last year's, indicating little recovery from the previous poor season.

One and one-half pounds sausage meat, 4 cup stale bread cubes, 1/2 cup melted fat, 1 teaspoon salt, 1/2 teaspoon pepper, 1/2 cup or more finely chopped onion, 1/2 teaspoon or more poultry seasoning or a mixture of sage, thyme and marjoram.

Form sausage meat into patties and brown on one side. Remove crusts from stale bread and cut into 1/2 inch cubes. Mix with fat and seasonings, using fat cooked from sausage. If compact stuffing is liked add 1/2 cup hot water or milk.

Despite the much lower cost of most synthetic vanilla extracts, the natural bean vanilla has resumed its prewar role at the top of the flavor market.

The word vanilla is from the Spanish, and means "little pod." In each of the now widely scattered species of the vanilla plant, the little pod is preceded by a dainty yellow bloom which leaves no doubt that the plant belongs to the orchid family.

Spaniards took the plant home to Europe, from where it eventually reached the eastern tropics. Its progress was greatly advanced a century ago when a Negro slave began hand pollination of the flowers on the island of Reunion.

In cultivation, the vanilla plant is started from cuttings of vines of determined hardness and bean quality. It is trained to grow on cross posts or on living trees.
