

Michigan's winter birds are hardy, and quite capable of taking care of themselves. The total winter feeding is too small to have effect on bird populations. But the benefits of making close friends of the birds of the neighborhood, and watching them daily makes feeding shelves well worth while for the observer.

State bread put through a food grinder, table scraps and suct will suffice at a feeding shelt, but sunflower seed, corn and other grain may prove more attractive balt.
