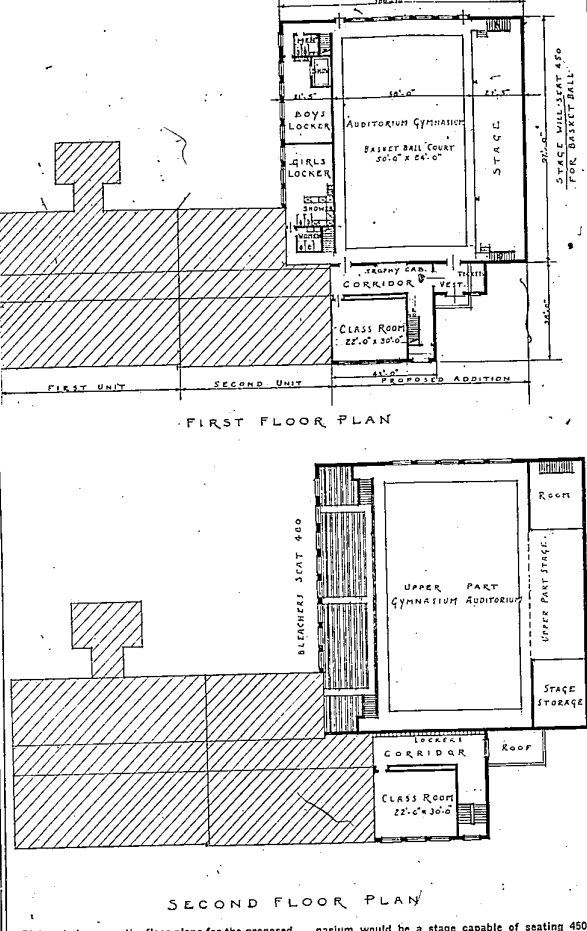

Floor Plans Of Proposed Clarenceville Addition



Picture above are the floor plans for the proposed gymnasium-auditorium addition to the Clarenceville school on Middlebelt Road just south of Eight Mile Road, which the residents of the District will vote on March 23.
 The top illustration shows the layout of the proposed first floor of the addition. The center of the building would house an auditorium-gymnasium 58 ft. by 96 ft. To the right of the gymnasium would be a stage capable of seating 450 persons. Also on the first floor would be boys and girls locker rooms plus one class room at the front of the addition.
 Another classroom would be constructed on the second floor in addition to bleachers looking out over the gymnasium-auditorium with a seating capacity of 480. An auxiliary room and storage space would also be available on this floor.
