as is adopted in the metropolitan area.  
Another matter which received some discussion was the discontinuance of water service for residents who are away from their Farmington homes during the winter months. It was voted to make a charge of \$1.25 for turning water off, and \$1.25 for turning the service back on again. It was also moved to cancel water bills for nonusers of water, during the last quarter for which bills have just been issued.

**TO HIRE ADDITIONAL MAN**  
The need for adding a man to the Department of Public Works was discussed, and Superintendent Harvey Blough was authorized to hire a man at \$200.00 per month. Work in this department is much heavier during the summer, and there is

not sufficient help at the present time to take care of it.  
Commissioner Emory Hutton also brought up the need for making some street repairs. Although it is still too early to do much repair work, as the streets must dry out completely before any permanent repair work can be done, it was decided that it might help to use the roller in some places now, and help smooth out the ruts and holes. Some particularly bad spots will have to be patched now, to temporarily help out until a more permanent repair can be done.

The Commission passed a Resolution giving their cooperation and support to the Farmington Area Recreation Commission. Dr. M. E. Whitehead, chairman of the recreation group, was present at the meeting and discussed the proposed program.
