

## 'Art' Is Show Theme

The second largest stamp show in Michigan will be held this weekend in Plymouth, with the theme "Art on Stamps."

Sponsored by the West Suburban Stamp Club, the show will be held April 29 and 30 in Plymouth Central Junior High School, Main and Church. Saturday it will be open from 10 a.m. to 9 p.m. and Sunday, from 1 to 6 p.m.

THIS YEAR, the show will be held in conjunction with the Kaleidoscope Plymouth celebration, a series of events built around Arttrain's visit to Plymouth.

memorative cachets will be issued for the show.

This year's show will also feature a 200 - frame exhibition, including a 50 - frame court of honor of prize-winning exhibits from Michigan area shows.

Exhibitors will compete for more than \$200 in prizes, as well as for many special awards, including one for the exhibit that best expresses the theme of the show.

THE 24 - DEALER bourse

will include representatives from five states and Canada. Collectors will also have an opportunity to purchase mint stamps at face value from the U.S. UN and Canadian postal services.

Refreshments will be served, and there will be no admission charge.

Although only 2 1/2 years old, the West Suburban Stamp Club is now the largest in the Detroit area, with more than 100 members. This is its third stamp show.
