1909 constitution also fixes the salary of secretary of state, state treasurer and auditor general at \$2,500 a year.

How does Michigan manage to induce qualified citizens to serve as a state official? Answer: By a legislative subterfuge, upheld by the state supreme court, of allowing either an additional salary for membership on the state administrative board, or in the case of the governor, an "expense account" with no strings attached.

Governor Siger is paid \$20,000 a year on this basis. Other state officials get \$7,500 a year with the exception of the lieutenant governor who draws \$3,500 a year plus \$3 a day, or around \$4,500. Governor Dewey and Governor Warren are paid \$25,000 a year by their respective states — New York and California. Further adjustments in the governor's compensation may be forthcoming in the future when the governor's residence at Lansing is ready for occupancy.

Ballot proposal No. 4 would permit adjustment of the \$3 per day salary now paid to members of the legislature. Since this amount is paid daily, whether the legislature is in session or not, the year's compensation averages \$1,095.

New York pays \$2,500 a year plus actual traveling expenses for a round trip once a week; Pennsylvania, \$3,000 for each session and \$500 for a special session; Illinois, \$5,000 for two year term plus 10 cents a mile traveling expense; and Ohio, \$2,000 a year plus traveling mileage once a week.

On a basis of compensation for times served at Lansing during a session of the legislature, Michigan legislators received the following salary: 1947 session, 158 days, \$4.95 per day; 1948 special session, 67 days, \$15 per day. Twenty-one states now permit

## TEMPORARY UNIT NEAR COMPLETION AT CLARENCEVILLE

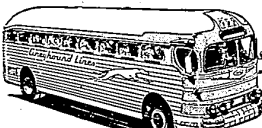
