

Michigan Bell To Ask Permission To Increase Telephone Rates

however, would be available to the company after taxes.

Emphasizing the seriousness with which Michigan Bell views its financial situation, the company will ask for \$10,000,000 of the amount it needs as "immediate relief to meet increased payroll costs and other urgent expenses." In accordance with the recommendation of a fact-finding panel appointed by the Governor, Michigan Bell has offered its employed to the company of the company of the control o


