**RSL Sets Film, Talk On Retarded**

The film "No Miracle But Love" and a report on care of retarded children in the Evangelical home in Detroit will be on the program for the Redford Suburban League meeting at 12 noon Wednesday, March 14.

The league, which since its beginnings has earmarked its funds for helping retarded children, will meet for lunch in Vladimir's Restaurant, Eight Mile and Grand River, Farmington.

In an unusual move, the group has invited township school and civic organization leaders to share in the program and learn more of the current programs for these children.

The speaker will be Mrs. Betty Clues, program director of the Children's Evangelical Home.

She will tell about a pilot program that was begun about a year ago and resulted in the transfer of 48 children from the Plymouth State Home.

"These youngsters are rated within the trainable intelligence range and attend the Engel School for the retarded."

The film to be shown was produced in the Bethesda Lutheran Home in Ballimore and has been seen on television. It depicts the programs for the retarded in the Maryland school.

Mrs. Clues will receive a donation for the Evangelical Home from the Suburban League.

Stella Braasch is program chairman for the meeting and Betty Meyers, philanthropies chairman, will present the gift to the evangelical home.
