
Nichols, who resides at 33002 Maplenut, Farmington, was singled out for his contributions to the student group and various projects to promote understanding between racial

Curtis Anderson, advisor to the student group, stated that the award was "to emphasize the outstanding service made by Dr. Nichols to minority students at the college."


