S'craft Chiefs Will Be Kept At 31; None Added

Schoolcraft College trustees have mandated President C. Nelson Grote to keep the administration to 31 persons but have left any transfers and changes to Dr. Grote's discretion.

The board of trustees confirmed publicly the direction given to Dr. Grote at an "executive" (secret) session on Feb. 20. The session was called to discuss privately Dr. Grote's proposals for changing the administrative structure.

His elaborate proposals recommended that at least two new administrators be hired for 1973-74 and that several new administrators be added in the next few years.

While many trustees agreed with his long-range plans, they declined to add two new administrators next year because of a tight budget.

Dr. Grote has power to change his administration as he sees fit without board approval. He said, however, he will inform the board of changes when plans are final.

At least one of his proposals has come under fire from faculty members. Fernon Feenstra, electronics instructor, gave trustees a petition signed by 25 vocational instructors requesting that the director of apprenticeship remain a full time position rather than be made part time, as Dr. Grote has suggested.

The apprenticeship program depends heavily on speedy responses to industry and is "destined for less enrollment" if a full time administration isn't retained, he said.

"When industry calls about an apprentice, it wants an answer right away," Feenstra said. "If industry can't get that service right away at Schoolcraft, it can get it from Henry Ford (Community College)," he said.

Dr. Grote said that as a member of the state advisory board for vocational education, he has been an "avid spokesman for apprenticeship and will continue to be so."

"I have no intention of destroying or taking away

from any program, but only to better use the administration," Dr. Grote said.
