**Upstate Survey Discloses Decline in Well Levels**

The downward trend in water levels is continuing according to January measurements of wells by the geology division of the conservation department. Close to 50 shallow wells in the upper part of the lower peninsula were tested.

The decline was temporarily halted by a slight rise in December, but judging from past years it is not expected to level off until February.

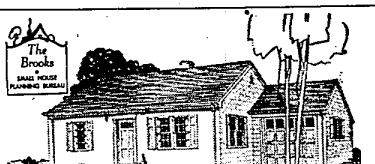
This month's average groundwater stage of 1.47 feet is only .05 feet higher than the record January low of 1947 and is 1.4 feet below the record January high set in January, 1946.

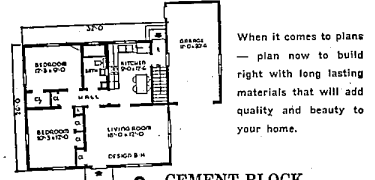

**Sale Of 1949 Auto Plates Lagging**

Curt Hall, manager of the Secretary of State's license bureau in Farmington, announced this week that he has sold 500 fewer plates than this time a year ago. All Farmington area car owners are urged to call at Curt Hall's, 33224 Grand River, Farmington, and get their 1949 license plates now and not wait until the February 28 deadline.

The lagging in sale of license plates is not confined only to the Farmington area, Hall said. Secretary of State Fred M. Alger, Jr. stated this week that only 270,657 people have obtained their new 1949 license plates since they were put on sale in December.

In 1948 the Secretary of State's department issued 2,259,074 plates, which means that 1,989,417 motor car owners in Michigan must still visit Secretary of State's offices before March 1. Alger also reminds all car owners that the Michigan law will not permit the use of a 1949 license plate after midnight, February 28.

Hall stated that motorists can avoid standing in line for long periods by getting their licenses now before the deadline rush begins.

At the present time there are 47 units of the organization, consisting of 1291 boys participating in the Boy Scouts, Sea Scouts and Cub Pack activities, under the leadership of 475 adult leaders. McMillin came to Oakland County from the Ottawa-Allegan field office.

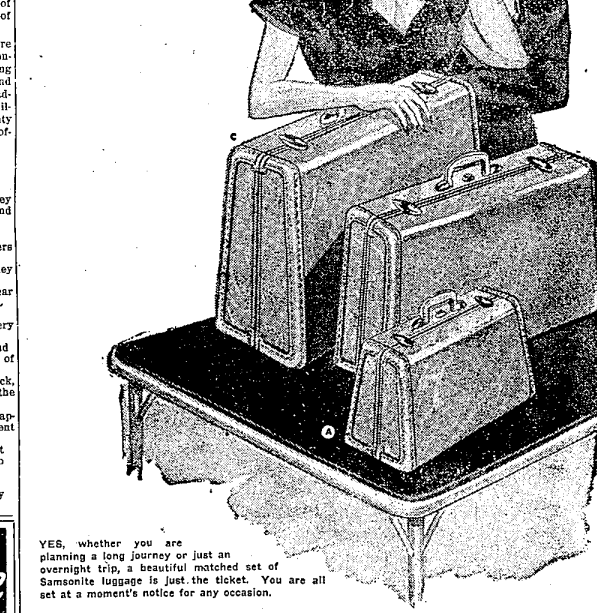
