### Miles Helm Opens Shop For Watch Repairing

Farmington can now enjoy the services of another place of business specializing in watch repairs with the opening of the new office of Miles Helm.

Helm, member of the Horological Institute of America, of the U. S. Bureau of Standards, opened his service shop this week at 23629 Farmington Road, just off Grand River. He will occupy a portion of the office of the City Cab building.

The gentle heat from a flexible snake of heating cable along the eaves of a house is enough to prevent formation of roof-reeking ice dams in winter, according to heating specialists. The ice ridge along a roof's edge, a familiar headache to many a homeowner, causes water draining from the roof to back up beneath the shingles and leak into the house. The lead-covered heating cable, easily bent to fit a variety of jobs, can maintain the temperature necessary to melt drainage grooves (it melts ice as it flows).
