Mary's hit on two long shots. Four points each by McLean and Bryant and three by Wieland gave Farmington an 11 to 5 lead as the second period opened.

In the second quarter Bryant and McLean continued their scoring spree, winning 15 points between them as the Falcons led 29 to 14 at the half.

St. Mary's came out after the half determined to win. They held the Falcons to 4 points in the next 10 minutes, largely because of the accuracy of Dombrowski from the free throw line. However, Farmington held a 33 to 24 lead at the end of the third period.

The aroused Falcons sewed up the game in the final quarter. Three goals by McLean, one each by Duell and Bryant, and a free shot by Tupper gave Farmington 11 points. This made a 44 to 32 victory for Farmington as St. Mary's was held to 8 points in the last quarter.

High point honors were taken by Fred McLean, Falcon guard. His 21 points was the highest single game total made by any varsity player this season.

In the Class C district playoffs, Clarencville defeated Dearborn Roosevelt High School by a score of 28 to 20. In the first period, marked by exceptionally low scoring, Clarencville went in front 4 to 2. At halftime, Roosevelt edged out the local school by a score of 11 to 10. At the end of the third period, Clarencville again led the lead at 20 to 13, and never relinquished it. Final score for the Clarencville Trojans over Roosevelt was 44 to 20. High scorer was Dick Latimer with eight points.

On Saturday night, Clarencville met the winner of the St. Alphonsus Sacred Heart Playoff, and emerged on the low end of a 29 to 27 score.

The game got off to a slow start with both teams feeling each other out, and at the end of the first period, St. Alphonsus was ahead 4 to 3. At the half, they had enlarged their lead to 14 to 7. The third period score showed that Clarencville was still in there trying, and had narrowed the gap to 21 to 17. In the last period Clarencville won 29 to 27.
