

SALE OF STATE LAND IS RESTRICTED BY AVAILABLE ACRES

With inquiries about northern state lands for sale on market lists averaging 35 or more a day, the conservation department's lands division is asking inquirers to be sure to specify the counties in which they are interested.

At present there is no acreage immediately available on market lists in Alcona, Alpena, Arenac, Clare, Crawford, Gladwin, Iosco, Isabella, Manistee, Mecosta, Mason, Montmorency, Muskegon, Ogemaw, Oscoda, Oshtemo and Roscommon counties.

Counties in which less than 100 acres is available are Cheboygan, Grand Traverse, Lake Leelanau, Missaukee, Newaygo, Oceana, Presque Isle, Westford, Dickinson and Keweenaw.

Less than 300 acres is available in Benzie, Emmet, Midland, Osego, Gogebic and Mackinac counties. In Antrim, Charlevoix, Alger, Delta, Menominee, Ontonagon and Schoolcraft counties there is under 500 acres which can be purchased. Luce and Marquette counties have under 800 acres. Baraga, Chippewa, Houghton and Iron counties have more than 1,000 acres while Kalamazoo county has under 1,000 acres. County maps showing state owned acreage descriptions will be mailed free of charge, if ordered singly. A complete set of maps in book form for all counties north of the Day City - Muskegon line is available for \$2.50.

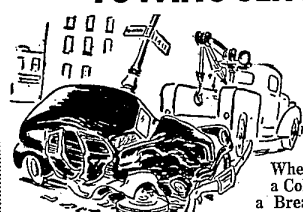
