In most cases it's due to too much water, or poor drainage. Don't make the mistake of putting hairy, thomy and waxed! leaved plants in the same planter, as these all require different watering.

Plants in plastic or glazed containers do not dry out as quickly as plants in a clay pot. When you set plants in, place pot and all so that if one dies, you can lift it out completely without disturbing the others.

Trees can be planted in residential areas for a number of reasons for shade, for beauty, for song birds and for conservation.

In rural areas trees have been planted for reforestation, wildlife habitat improvement, farmstead, and feed of windbreaks, as well as those reasons given in residential planting.

In addition to the trees, a packet of 250 assorted hardwood shrubs is available at \$8 per packet. Some of the shrubs are: autumn olive, silky dogwood, Washington hawthorne and Siberian crab. All of the shrubs produce fruit that is preferred food for a variety of song birds.
