U. M. Announces Local Graduates

Graduates of the University of Michigan for the year total 5,190, culminating with the conferring of 3,445 degrees at the June commencement on Saturday, June 11. Justice Bruce Dittmas Bromley, for many years a leading member of the New York bar and rector named to the State's highest court, delivered the address to the graduates on "The Conservative's Role in America."

President Alexander G. Ruthven conferred the 3,445 diplomas to the largest June class in the history of the University, breaking last year's mark of 3,253. The total of 6,190 for the year, counting graduates at the end of the 1948 Summer Session and last February, also establishes a new mark, exceeding the 1947-48 total by 309. Doctor Warns Of Bad Water
Persons who plan to build a lake or farm home should give careful consideration to the location and construction of their well before they begin, so that the water will not be contaminated, Dr. Bruce H. Douglas, commissioner of health, advised this week. Money and time can be saved by getting good advice at the very outset. In rearranging sewage disposal systems, proper care should be taken to protect the drinking water supply. After the changes are made, the water supply should be examined again. Dr. Douglas suggests that prospective vacationers have a sample of the drinking water from their cottages tested now. Detroit residents may have this done without cost by bringing a sample to the laboratory. Sterile containers supplied by the Department of Health must be used to collect these water samples. The containers and instructions about how to take the samples may be picked up at the laboratory at Herman Kiefer Hospital or at the Department of Health at 334 Bates Street. Until you are sure that the water is safe, boil drinking water for ten minutes, or add five drops of commercial liquid laundry bleach to each gallon of clear water or add ten drops if the water is turbid. The bleach must be in contact with the water for thirty minutes at least. These regulations must be completely and carefully carried out to be sure the water is safe.
