Graydon Blank, MSC extension sheep specialist, reports that each of the 19 recognized purebred breeds of sheep will be represented either in judging and type discussion or in a general breed discussion. Various types of equipment equipment and commercial stocks will be on exhibit, representing ewes and lambs from the high stocks in the Wolverine Lamb Production Project will also be on display.

A highlight of the program will be a parasite control demonstration by Dr. Frank Phibbs, MSC veterinarian. A demonstration with sheep dogs is also scheduled.
