payment including interest and taxes on a two-bedroom house varies between \$40 and \$47. The VA requires interest of not more than 4 per cent on such mortgages. This advantage to the veteran becomes a handicap because of the difficulty in finding lenders in view of the lack of cash payment, who will accept this lower-than-going rate.

"Private builders have advocated that Congress should increase the interest rate to 4 1/2 per cent, the prevailing rate paid by non-veteran home-owners. This would make veteran mortgages equally attractive and marketable."

One requirement in the new federal housing act, recently adopted by Congress, is that cities which obtain federal housing subsidies must eliminate slum dwellings in an amount equal to the number of new public housing units provided.

A Washington business service has assured home builders that the federal housing program will call for only about 15 per cent of the housing industry's total capacity of one million homes per year. As subsidized rents are limited to low-income workers, it is the intent of Congress that the program will meet a demand almost never filled in the past by private builders.

Governor Williams may have had this in mind when he declared builders had failed to do the job. Home builders do not agree.

In the long run, the public will be the judge.

## Pheasant Surveyors Report 40% Increase

Farmer cooperators, making their first summer pheasant survey of the season, report seeing 40 per cent more nests and 60 per cent more broods compared to last year at this time.

Farmer cooperators are a group of interested farmers reorganized for making pheasant counts by county agents, conservation officers and conservation district game men.

In their first of six semi-monthly counts, conservation officers say they have spotted more than twice as many broods this summer, but believe they will have a better index of the situation through the checks to be made in the next few weeks. Most hatches were early this year.

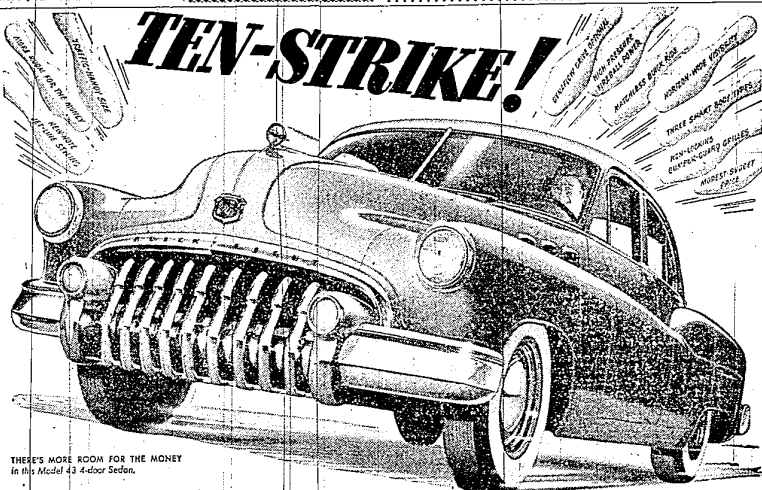

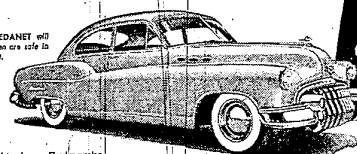
