Hunting Licenses Available September 15

Michigan's 3,700 hunting licenses agents will have a stock of licenses for the coming hunting season begretiment of 5, the conservation department reports. Application blanks for the special anterless deer season also will be distributed der geason also will be distributed with first license shipments to dealers since the applications must be returned to the department's general operations division by October 10. No hunting season opens be-fore October 1.

In addition to the Michigan ilcense, hunters of ducks and geese
must purchase, attach and cancel
with a signature a federal migratory waterfowl stamp. Stamps can
be jurchased only at the post office!


