

The 1349 regulations, therefore, reflect this expressed preference. This action, we feel, will benefit a larger number of sportsmen than any other regulatory liberalization we could make at this time."

It will be lawful to take four ducks per any of which not more than one may be a wood duck, and for one person to possess not more than eight ducks but not more than one wood duck. Four geese except Ross geese may be taken in one day or held in possession, of which two may be Canada or white-fronted geese, or one of each. In addition, 25 American and red-reasted mersangers, singly or in the aggregate, may be taken in the aday, with no limit to the number which may be held in possession.

sion. Bag possession limits for coots are reduced from 15 to 10 birds because they are scatter in Central and Mississippi flyway states (Michigan is in the latter). Bag and possession limits for sora rail are increased from 20 to 25 birds. Bag and possession limits remain unchanged, four a day, eight in possession.
