Size Limit Abandoned For All Pan Fish

Any length pan fish is "keeper" size the conservation department points out to fishermen regulations clear on the new fishing regulations which went into effect late last month.

Conservation officers and other department field men are telling anglers that the removal of the six-inch size limit applies to bluegills, sunfish, perch, rock and catfish. Size limits on pike-perch (walleyes) have not been removed, but reduced from 14 to 13 inches. The 14-inch minimum length on northern pike continues, as does the 10-inch size limit on large and smallmouth black bass.

MSC Granted \$1500 For Vitamin Research

A grant of \$1,500 for continuance of a study to more efficiently calculate potency of Vitamin "D" as used in fish liver oils and similar materials has been received by Michigan State College from the Parke, Davis Company of Detroit. The money was part of gifts and grants totaling \$3,600 accepted for the college by the State Board of Agriculture.

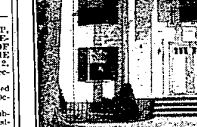
Third Journalism Day To Be Held At MSC

big profits on the commodity market.
IS SENATOR IN LARD?
In August, Cullum began pestering the agriculture department to support hard prices. Naturally, such support would cause a spectacular jump in hard prices.

The agriculture department, however, has adopted a policy of supporting only agricultural products not by-product such as lard, it feels, would not help farmers, but the meat packers.

Nevertheless, Cullum phoned George Parks in the fats and oils branch in the name of Senator Thomas and demanded a price support for lard. Parks promised a written reply, and when it did not come fast enough, Cullum made two phone calls to David

Pettus in the livestock branch for information on price supports. Again he suggested that the government buy lard. Each time he represented himself as speaking for Senator Thomas and the senate agricultural committee.

As a result of Cullum's activity, the agriculture department finally sent a letter to Senator Thomas. "This is in reply to a recent telephone request from Mr. Dyke Cullum to the fats and oils branch for information regarding the calculation of a parity price for lard. As you know, the parity price committee heretofore has applied only to direct agricultural commodities sold by farmers. It has not applied to products such as fats and oils which are processed from agricultural products and sold by processors."

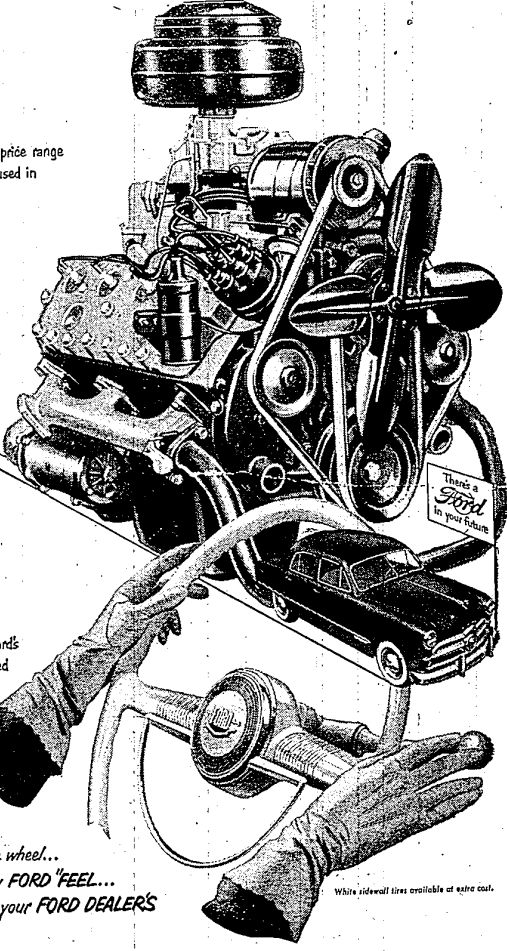
