If the address proves incomplete or incorrect, your warmhearted Christmas greetings land in the Dead Letter Office.

"One of the saddest sights on Christmas Eve," says the Postmaster, "are the many undeliverable Christmas cards. Each represents a bit of Yuletide sentiment. Practically all are the result of carelessness. Especially illegible handwriting, inadequate addresses, and stamps that fall off en route because they weren't affixed properly."

"Please address plainly and completely," he emphasizes. "Give the full name, house number, street, name of city, zone number, and state. Many emergency and regular carriers are required to figure out scrawled addresses that would puzzle a bill collector."

And don't forget to write your return address on the envelope. The Postmaster said return addresses on Christmas cards has the warm approval of the highest authorities on etiquette, because it helps friends keep their address books up-to-date.

Cards receive more considerate handling if they're mailed before the peak Christmas rush, the Postmaster pointed out. Greetings for out-of-state delivery should be posted by December 15, and for local delivery at least a week before Christmas.

Idea If such service is rendered. Groups not allied with the school will be charged \$45.00 plus \$5.00 custodian fee for use of the gymnasium-auditorium for three hours or less and \$10.00 plus \$1.25 custodian fee for each hour additional. The study hall charge will be \$7.50 plus \$1.25 for each hour of custodial service if rendered. The classroom charge will be \$5.00 plus \$1.25 for each hour of custodial service if rendered and the charge for the use of the kitchen will be \$5.00. All groups not allied with the school District will pay an advance fee of \$10.00, which shall be returned in case of proper cancellation.

All requests for use of facilities shall be in writing and the Superintendent will handle all non-school applications. Holders of permits may cancel them by giving the issuing office notice at least 24 hours in advance of the date to be cancelled. All groups using the facilities will be held responsible for any damages to school property. No alcoholic beverages are allowed in the building nor are any intoxicating persons allowed in the building and any group entering the school must be under proper adult supervision. No smoking will be allowed in the gymnasium.

No parties, dances or similar activities shall be held later than 11:30 p.m. so that the building may be cleared by 12:00 midnight unless special permission is granted at the time of the issuance of the permit. The Board reserves the right to make exceptions or refuse the use of facilities at any time. No outside group shall be allowed to use the school facilities for carnivals or similar money-making activities.
