# Move To Cut Loss In Stored Wheat

Farmers and elevator operators in Michigan are losing considerable money because of deteriorated wheat, reports Clarence Prentice, marketing specialist in agricultural economics at Michigan Stato Col-

marketing specialist in agricultural secondies at Michigan State College.

Prentice says much of the wheat was farm stored at a high moisture content. Temperatures and hunidity were unusually high this fall, and the wheat idi not dry out after storing. Instead, it started to sprout, and in many cases the germ died causing what is known as 'sick' wheat. Such wheat is very low in milling quality. Much of it would not grow if planted.
