ELECTION LAW, REVISION OF 1943

(3093) Section 1. On the day of any election the poils shall be continued at 7 o'clock in the forencom, and shall be continued open until 8 o'clock in the afternoon and no longer. Every qualified elector present and in line at the poils at the hour prescribed for the closing thereof shall be allowed to vote. THE POLLS of said election will be open at 7 o'clock a.m. and will remain open until 8 o'clock p.m. of said day of election.
