
Farmington Assembly of God, Grand River at Middlebelt, will show the movie "The Prodigal Son" at 7:30 p.m. Sunday evening, May 7.

## X-Ray Trailer To Arrive Monday

Residents of the Clarenceville School District and Livonia will have an opportunity to have free chest x-rays taken between Monday, May 8, and May 17.

The x-ray unit sponsored by the Wayne County Health Department and the Clarenceville High School will be at the Clarenceville High School on Monday, May 8, and Tuesday, May 9. Students of the District who are 15 years of age and over will have a chance to have x-rays taken on Monday from 9:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. On Tuesday the mobile unit will be back at the school from 10:00 a.m. to 12 noon to take care of students not x-rayed on Monday. For the convenience of residents of the District, the mobile x-ray unit will be open from 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, May 9, and from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. on Wednesday, May 10. Disrobing is not necessary for the x-rays and it only takes a few minutes. All reports are confidential.

The purpose of the x-ray unit is to make this free service easily available to residents of the area in the interest of care and treatment of tuberculosis. Early detection of TB can often save lives and prevent costly treatment and possible long hospitalization.

## Jitney Service Discontinued

The Farmington Transit Service, running a "jitney bus" through two loops in the City of Farmington, has discontinued operations. Jack Schwelzer, manager of the service, said insufficient passenger revenue was the reason for discontinuing the service after a two week trial period.

"I thought more and cheaper transportation would bring people into town more often — which would help everybody — but they still preferred the taxi service," Schwelzer stated. He added that the service would have been continued had operating revenue been sufficient to meet operating expenses. However, the idea of a "jitney bus" service for the Farmington area is still considered, Schwelzer stated. Another trial may be made this fall.

At their dinner meeting Monday night, the organization was split into two teams, one captained by Dean Eckert, the other by Ernest Hickman. The teams will compete for largest ticket sales, with the losers to stake the winners to refreshments at a party to be held later in the summer.

Bill Conroy is chairman of the Fun Bowl committee this year, with assistance from Roy Brown on publicity and Ed West on ticket promotion.

The Jaycees are completing plans for their fourth annual Fun Bowl, a bowling exhibition to be held at Farmington Recreation on May 26. As in past years, the Fun Bowl will feature unconventional bowling techniques such as bowling backwards, bowling with a soft ball, bowling one frame with the right hand and one with the left, trying for the lowest number of pins, etc. A number of alleys will be set up for straight, high score bowling, as well as the screwball type. Awards will be presented to the winners in each event.

schools never buy their own bleachers, believing they can rent bleachers cheaper than they could maintain their own." He advocates that Farmington rent bleachers also. Hall also said that the location of Farmington's field would compare favorably to other schools in the Inter-Lakes league. Only one school has their field adjoining the high school — Krop's field is 1/2 mile away. Hall also stated Farmington's proposed location puts it in better position for handling traffic. According to Hall, Nine Mile Road could be made one-way before games to handle incoming traffic, and cars could leave via the Cut-Off, Nine Mile, or Gill Road.
